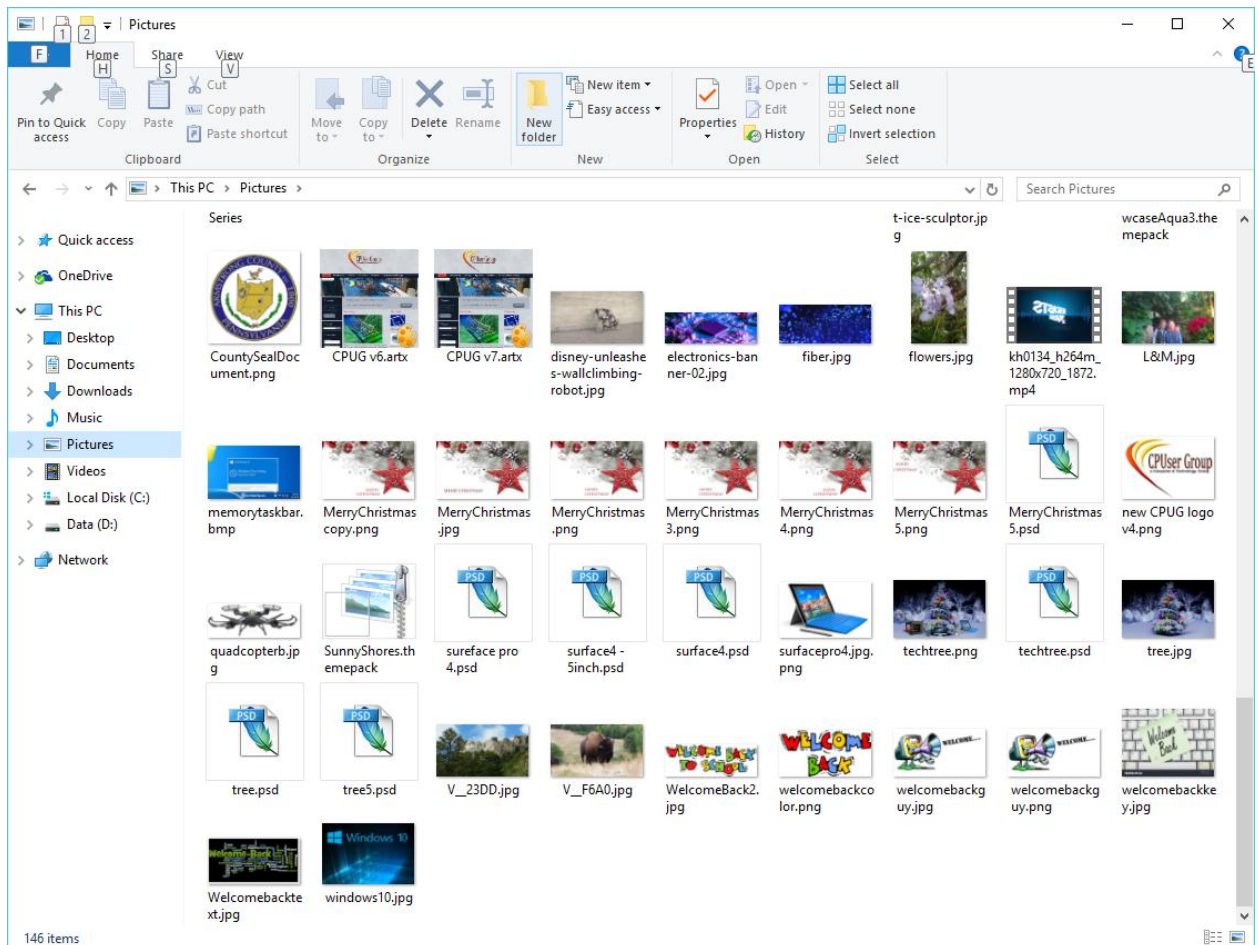


# How to Save the Lock Screen SpotLight Pictures

## Part 1

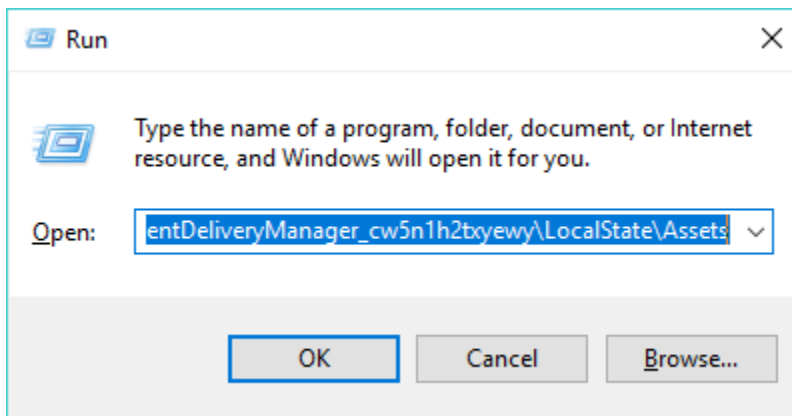
1. Click on the **Library folder** to open it.
2. Click on the **Pictures folder** to open it.
3. Click on the **New folder icon** on the menu ribbon to create a folder and type the name **Spotlight**.



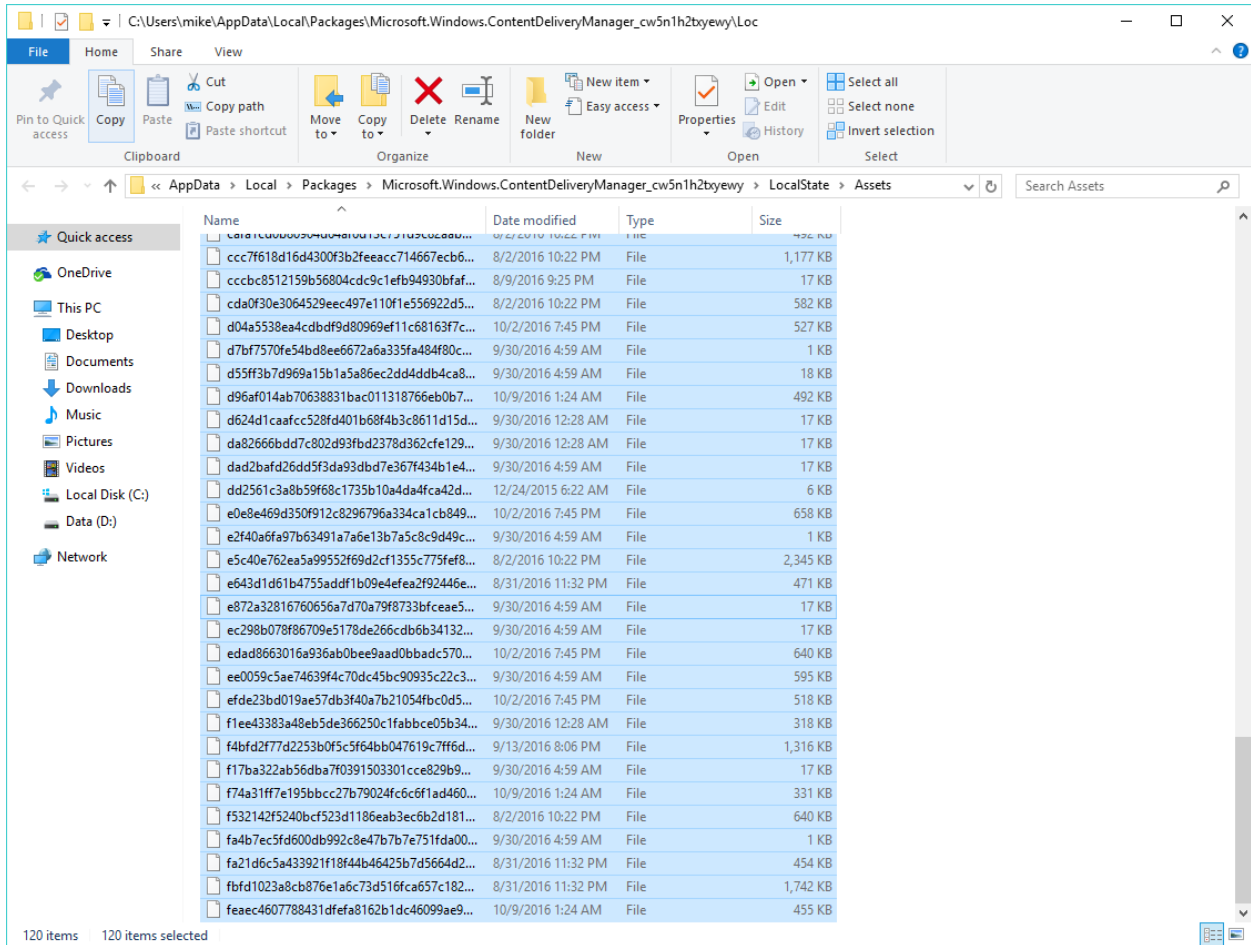
## Part 2

1. **Right click** on **Start Button** and select **Run**.
2. **Copy** or **Type** the below text into the **Open** field.

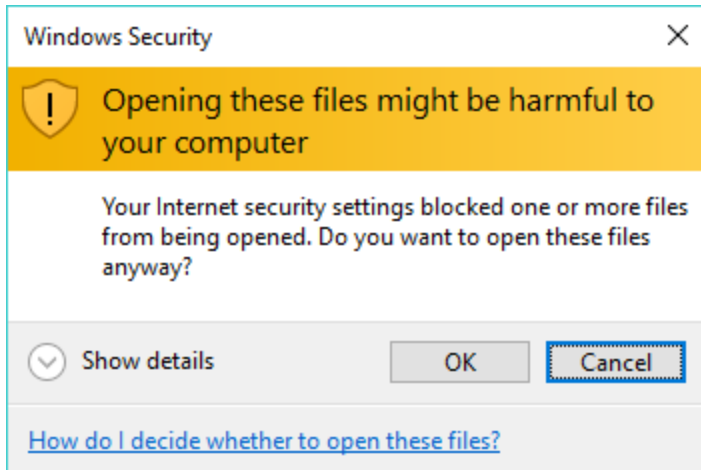

- Click inside the window that appears and press **Select all** in the menu ribbon (or **CTRL A**) to select all the files.

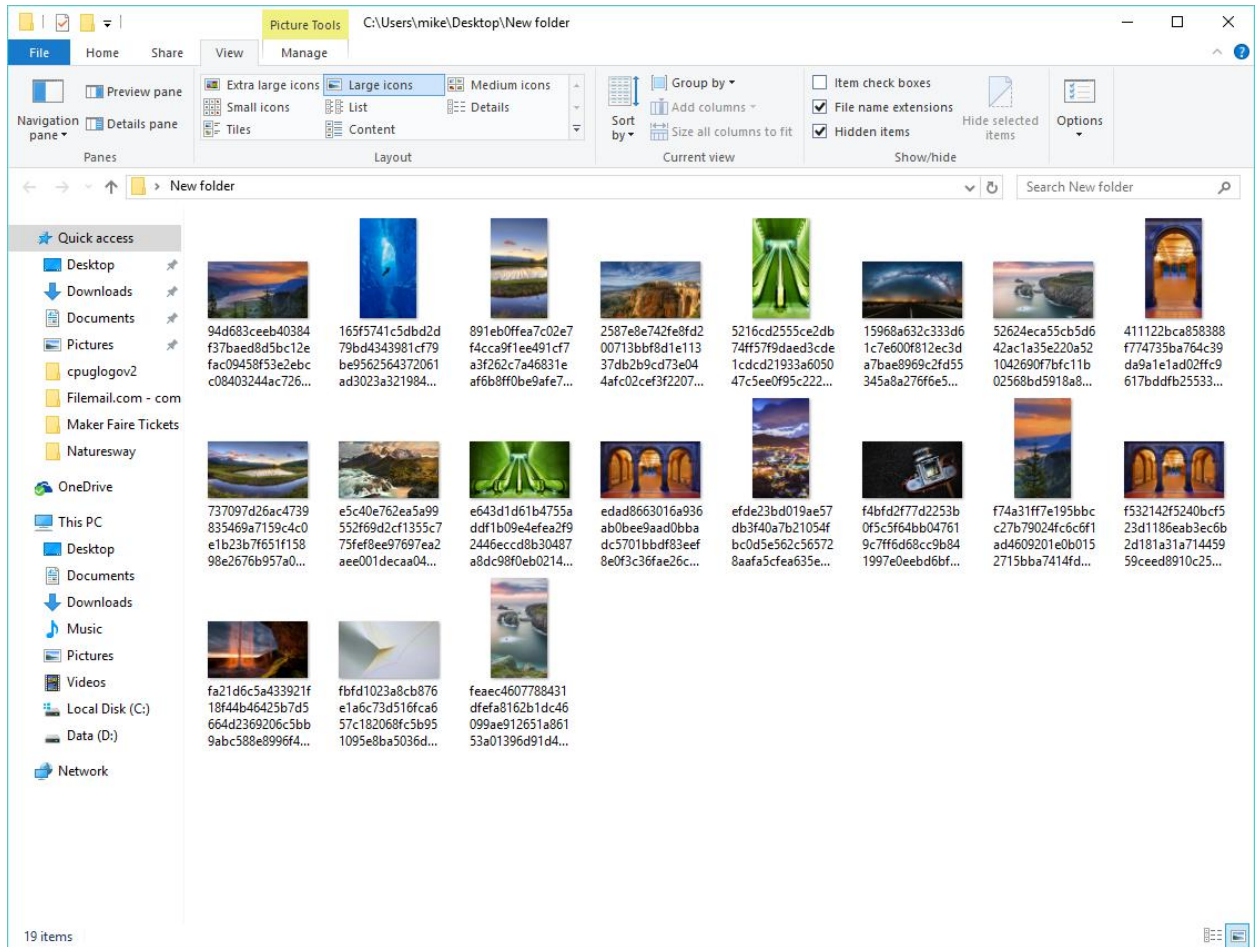


- Click **Copy** (or **CTRL C**) on the menu ribbon to copy the files.



5. Go to the pictures folder and open the **Spotlight folder**.
6. Click inside the **Spotlight folder** and press Paste in the menu ribbon (or **CTRL V**) to paste all the files.
7. Next **shift right click** in **spotlight folder** and select run open command window here.
8. In the **Dos window** that appears type **ren \*.\* \*.jpg** and then press the **Enter key**. (This will rename all file to become a jpg file.).

9. Next go back to the **Spotlight** folder and make sure the view is set to **Large icons**.



10. Now **highlight** any files that do not show an image and hit the **delete** key to remove them.
